MARDYKE VALLEY LOCAL RULES PENALTY AREAS:

Rule 17. All areas defined by yellow or red posts

Drop Zone at 8th Hole, as a Local Rule a player's ball that enters the penalty area may take relief at the drop zone under penalty of one stroke. This has been ith the

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS Rule 16.1.

All bridges, fences, internal pathways, fixed sprinkler heads, staked or newly planted trees

(Under 2 metres). Relief may be taken without penalty, no nearer the hole.

Overhead Wires under Rule 11: Ball in motion accidently deflected relief may be taken COURSE SAFETY:

Please ring bell next to the pond on the 6th hole to signal that you have reached the green.

Ensure the 7th green is clear before playing your shot. Please ring the bell after clearing the 7th green and after playing the 13th, 14th & 15th fairways. OUT OF BOUNDS & LOST BALL:

Out of bounds is defined by: White Posts or the borders and boundary edges and fences of the course is out of bounds. We adhere to the 2019 RandA rules regarding OOB and Lost Ball in general play conditions. GUR AREAS

Marked GUR areas are identified by white markings: Stoney areas on the course are subject to a 'free drop', at the nearest point of relief.

Penalty for Breach of Local Rule: Match Play - Loss of Hole Stroke Play - Two Strokes

PLEASE PLAY READY GOLE AND AVOID SLOW PLAY AS FAR AS POSSIBLE 2 HOURS AND 10 MINUTES IS THE AVERAGE TIME FOR A NINE ON OUR COURSE WHEN PLAYING AS A FOUR BALL.

White tees are competition tees and for the use of official club competitions and County matches ONLY!

INDEMNITY

All Golf related activities can be dangerous. It is a condition of membership and the use of the course and the facilities of Mardyke Valley Golf Club that players, visitors and members carry their own insurance and indemnify the Company against all claims in respect of injury, damage or loss arising out of their presence on the Course or in the Clubhouse area. The Company will accept no liability in respect of any injury, loss or damage however caused. Players are reminded of Rule 1 of the R & A Rules of Golf, which stresses the need for care and vigilance before striking a golf ball, which applies at all times. Particular care must be taken to look out for and give way to walkers using the public footpath passing the left hand side of the 7th fairway and left hand side of the 8th fairway, which are adjacent to the tees.
